STATE OF THE MARKET

- **Dominated By Departmental Integration**
- **Sluggish Growth, But Improving**
 - J2EE ADOPTION
 - LOW-COST ALTERNATIVES
 - REGULATORY DRIVERS
- **Early Consolidation / Shake-out**
 - LOW REVENUE (< \$100M) VENDORS WILL DISAPPEAR
- **Pent-up Demand**
 - J2EE CONVERSIONS
 - WEB SERVICES AND BPM
 - MARKET IMMATURITY



MARKET CONCERNS

- **66% Web Services**
- **56% Data and Semantic Integration**
- **55% BPM**
- **47% Enterprise Application Servers/Platform Suites**
- **41% BI/Performance Management**
- **41% Legacy Integration**
- **+ EII, EEM, ESB, BAM, BRM, BPO, RFID**

- **APPLICATION SERVER ERA**
 - 3 TIER
 - SCALABILITY KEY DRIVER
 - EARLY JAVA
- **SOA ERA**
 - GRANULARITY
 - SERVICES ABSTRACTION
 - WEB SERVICES



CURRENT STATE OF SOA

- **SOME MARKET CONFUSION**
 - DOES SOA = WEB SERVICES?
 - DOES ESB = SOA?
- **STANDARDS**
 - JAVA
 - XML
 - WEB SERVICES
- **CONVERTING APPLICATIONS TO SERVICES**
 - EXPOSE BUSINESS FUNCTIONS
 - MAKE LOOSELY COUPLED, DISTRIBUTED
 - *BUT* MAINTAIN INTEGRITY

THE SOA LESSON

Integration *Is* Development AND Development *Is* Integration

- **SOA Vision:**
“INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT AND INTEGRATION”
- **Benefits**
 - DESIGN/ANALYSIS (25%)
 - DEVELOPMENT (83%)
 - TEST/DEBUG (50%)
 - DEPLOYMENT (33%)
 - MAINTENANCE (36%)



THE SOA LESSON

Business IS NOT I.T.

- **Next Generation SOA Vision:**
 - “**INTEGRATED BUSINESS AND I.T.**”
- **The Business / I.T. Communications Gap**
 - BUSINESS ACTIVITY?
 - BUSINESS SERVICE?
 - BUSINESS TRANSACTION?
 - BUSINESS PROCESS?
- **Reduce Costs and Time, Improve Alignment**
- **The Goal? Business Model Driven I.T.!**
 - BEYOND I.T. MODEL-DRIVEN DEVELOPMENT.
